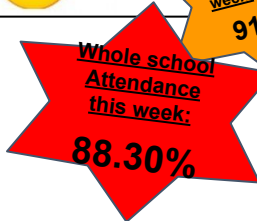
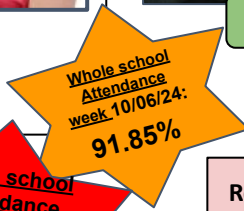
**Transition Day**
