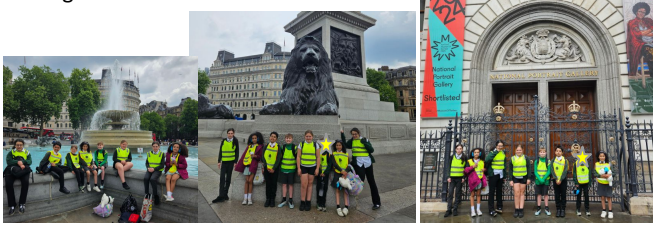
Sports for Champions & Superkind
