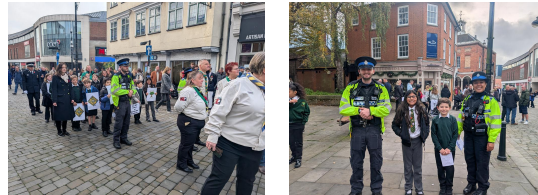
### Panto Response
