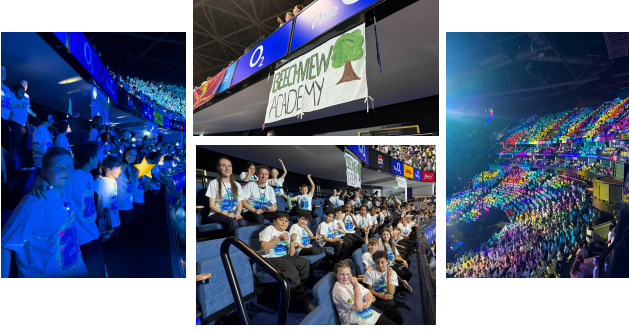


What is happening at Beechview
